In March, we honor both Women's History Month and International Transgender Day of Visibility (March 31).

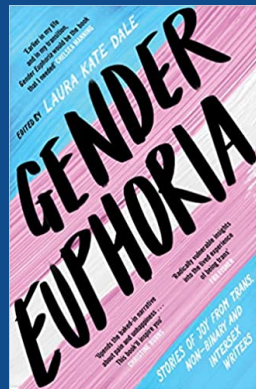
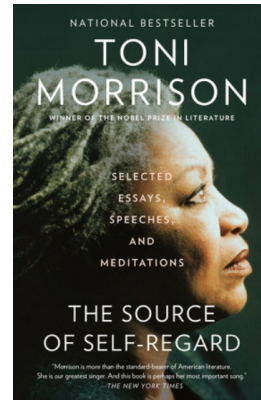

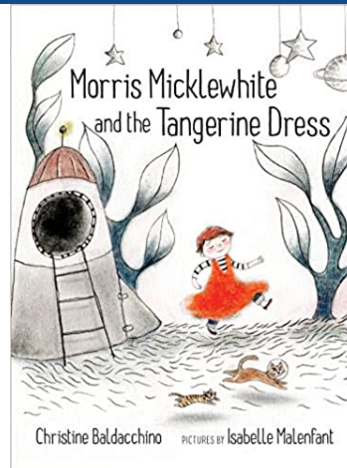
