VENDOR RESPONSIBILITIES & NOTES

- All confirmed vendors agree to comply with all the rules and regulations set forth by Atlantic Street Center (ASC) and Rainier Beach Community Center (RBCC/Seattle Parks & Recreation).
- Vendors understand that table spaces are on a first come, first serve basis. Exceptions include sponsors, major partners, and those with necessary accommodations.
- All registered vendors receive 1 (one) table. Additional tables will be limited, so please reach out to discuss this option as early as possible. If you have your own table, please let us know.
- Vendors to donate a gift from their business/organization that is worth at least \$25. No alcohol or tobacco related products
These gifts will be featured in multiple raffles throughout the event. Attendees can enter the raffles through our Event Passport. We recommend donated gifts be relevant to your business.
- Set up for vendors starts at 3:30 pm and should be completed by 4:15 pm.
Please do not arrive early to set up. Our event team needs the appropriate time to set up and receive vendors.
- Vendors will check in before choosing a table and commencing set up.
Vendors will wait for the plaza to be set up in full before checking in.
- We will have space for cars to drive on the plaza to assist with unloading.
- All cars must be off the plaza by 4:15 pm to accommodate for food trucks. No exceptions.
- Completion of this form does not confirm one's vendor space. You will receive a confirmation email once approved.

ABOUT THE SPACE

- There is limited parking at the Community Center. There are multiple accessible parking spots.
- We cannot provide access to electricity.
- Bathrooms are inside the Community Center.
- Atlantic Street Center and Rainier Beach Community Center (Seattle Parks & Recreation) cannot be responsible for any missing/stolen items, nor will there be space to lock up belongings. We advise you to be vigilant of your personal items.
- We cannot guarantee table placement. If you have a preference, let our team know and we will do our best to accommodate.
- Be cognizant of weather. Dress for multiple temperatures if possible.
- The space is near a school. Be mindful.

OTHER NOTES

- All food vendors get up to two food tickets. One per person.
- A FIFA game will be the next day (6/19), but please be cautious as there will be more people in the area than normal!
- The Community Center will still be available to patrons for regular use. Please be respectful of their space and the Community Center's rules throughout the event.
